 Consideration to recommend to the Mayor and City Council to authorize the City Manager to execute a lease amendment between the City of Laredo, as LESSOR, and Barker Aeromotive, as LESSEE, approved by Ordinance No. 2021-O-161 dated September 7, 2021 amending Section 1.03, Leases Premises, increasing leased premises from 33, 482 square feet to 35,647.05 square feet located at 4207 N. Jarvis Avenue at the Laredo International Airport. Monthly rent shall increase from \$11,667.55 to \$12,425.32. Additionally amending the lease term to include two (2) options to renew for an additional five (5) years each, ending in September 30, 2046 and September 30, 2051. All other terms and conditions remain unchanged and in effect; providing for severability; providing for an effective date.

- Consideration to recommend to the Mayor and City Council to authorize the City Manager to execute an amendment to the lease agreement between City of Laredo, as LESSOR, and General Services Administration (GSA), as LESSEE, approved by Ordinance No. 2020-O-094 dated August 03, 2020 for approximately 1,533 square feet constituting office space occupied by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) located at 5210 Bob Bullock Loop at the Laredo International Airport. An amendment to this lease is to extend for five (5) years for a term beginning on November 18, 2023, and expiring on November 18, 2028. The total annual rent shall be \$64,703.52. Total annual rent consists of \$58,851.87 of Shall Rent and \$5,851.65 of Operating Rent. All other terms and conditions of the lease agreement remain unchanged and in effect; providing for an effective date.
- Consideration to authorize a professional service contract with Zartico, Inc., Salt Lake City, UT, in the amount not to exceed \$25,000. The purpose is to provide certain technology services in support of air service development at the Laredo International Airport, to include data regarding PAX Volume (catchment & inbound), passenger insights, normalized geolocation data, and marketing and website analysis. The contract is a one-year term commencing on November 1, 2023, and ending October 31, 2024. Funding is available under the Airport Operation Funds
