He stated that posting of the agenda earlier or moving the meetings to be held on Tuesday instead of Monday will improve the flow of information to the people of Laredo.

Mr. Jerry Robinson, Laredo Health Director, stated that this issue had received local, national, and international attention on the discovery of the death of a youth who had swallowed water from the Rio Grande. He had placed announcements and warnings on August 8, 1994 to stay away and not swim in certain areas in the Rio Grande River in order to avoid the danger of the ameobae found containing high Coliform count and raw feces.

Cm. Casso asked if a councilmember requests information from the City Manager that he would like out of courtesy, that the City Manager deliver copies to the entire council regardless of who is asking for information.

Mr. Nava stated that they usually give all the councilmembers a copy unless in rare occasions when they are asked information verbally, that usually when there is a request for data to be collected, analyzed and prepared into a report they provide it to the whole council either through the newsletter or through a formal memorandum.

Cm. Casso stated if he has a request for information from the City Manager that he will send a copy to the other councilmembers and that he would like that the other councilmembers' copy of their requests be sent to him also.

Mr. Tellez stated that if information is requested on a particular citizen or on a particular case that is pending against the city, or something that involves the invasion of privacy regarding a citizen or an employee they cannot carbon copy everybody because they have to look out for the best interest of the person, but if it's general information that deals with policy and procedures, then it would be given to the council either through the newsletter or through formal memorandum.

Presentation by Luis E. Dovalina concerning the Texas Public Workers Association.

Mr. Luis Dovalina was speaking at the request of the Texas Public Workers Association to approach the council on payroll deductions and asked why can't they get their full line of deductions as requested by the association as it is done for other entities.

City Attorney Jose Tellez stated that the agreement that was entered into with NAGE was not proper, as a municipality we cannot recognize the collective bargaining unit other than the police officers or the firemen. That contract with NAGE for deductions was an illegal contract, therefore he had recommended to staff that they discontinue deducting dues for NAGE because they are not a recognized labor organization of the employees of the City of Laredo.

Mr. Tellez stated that the majority of the deductions that were itemized, that are being deducted from employees' payroll are related to fringe benefits and that the city provides to employees as a term of their employment.
