Marina Sukup, Planning Director, stated staff was recommending that the annexation be denied due to denial of a voluntary requirement of donating land for a fire station.

Arthur Zuniga, representing the Killam Developers, stated that they were not opposed to a fire station site located in the area, they just did not feel that their 155 acres should be burden with the requirement of donating the land. He stated that at the last meeting he did not have a formula on mind, but that he had sent correspondence to the city where they indicated that they felt that a formula should be made that would affect all property equally. He asked that certain citizens not be singled out for requirements that should affect all property.

Mayor Ramirez stated that they did not single out anyone, that they just happen to fall into an area that happens to

be owned by a property owner. He added that we have had occasions in the past that have worked fine in dedicating sites in voluntary requests for a fire station. They have not selectively gone out and picked out a property owner, it is such that the service plans that are provided to us by the fire chief indicate that this is the location that they would prefer to build a fire station and if unable to, that we do not develop into those areas as it would become for us in the long term a difficult scenario to address safety needs both for fire and emergency service without a station. He concluded by stating that there was a revised recommendation from staff to deny the request for annexation on this track pending additional annexation requirements on a voluntary basis.
