Nuevo Laredo Mayor Heberto Villarreal and members of the Nuevo Laredo City Councii, as well as other Mexican officials were introduced by Mr. Carlos R. Villarreal.

II. MEETING WITH THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF NUEVO LAREDO
TAMAULIPAS TO PRESENT AND DISCUSS ISSUES RELATED TO A
THIRD INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE BETWEEN NUEVO LAREDO, MEXICO
AND LAREDO, TEXAS.

Mr. Antonio C. Valdez, Nuevo Laredo Public Works Director described the proposed water treatment plant and other public works projects. Cost, which Mexican federal and state agencies would fund, would be approximately \$42 Million pesos.

Mr. Ramon Barrios, custom broker, inquired as to why the third bridge was proposed to be built to the North rather than to the South. The response was that warehousing and industrial parks are mostly to the North.

A Nuevo Laredo Councilmember inquired if Laredo, Texas had the funding available. It was explained that federal funds would be available.

After an interchange of border concerns relevant to the construction of a third bridge and its impact to both Laredos, it was concluded that such discussions would be continued in Nuevo Laredo with Tamaulipas Governor in attendance.

For this purpose, Mexican officials extended an invitation for Saturday, March 18th at 1:30 P.M. at La Noria Restaurant in Nuevo Laredo, Mexico.
