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17 With a quorum present, the Mayor called the meeting to
18 order and the following proceedings were carried out:

19 A brief presentation was made by Carlos Villarreal
20 regarding the application for "El Centro Development Project",
21 for an \$8.6 million Urban Development renovation of a grant
22 for the continuing renovation of the downtown area. This
23 application provides for an expansion of the Union National
24 Bank, a new Hachar's Building, and a parking garage. A \$1.7
25 million federal grant will provide for public expansion which

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1 will include the paving of streets, planting of trees and
2 installation of benches, trash receptacles, and street signs.


3 Mayor Aldo Tatangelo and Councilman Vidal Cantu, Jr.

6 Councilman Vidal Cantu, Jr. made a motion to close the
7 Public Hearing and reconvene with the Special City Council
8 Meeting. Second was by Councilman Santos Benavides. All

10 Next item was a resolution authorizing the submission of
11 a UDAG application to the U. S. Department of Housing and
12 Urban Development for El Centro Development Project. Motion
13 for its approval was made by Councilman Vidal Cantu, Jr.
14 Second was by Councilman Andres Ramos, Jr. All voted in
15 favor.

16 Motion for adjournment was made by Councilman Vidal
17 Cantu, Jr. Second was by Councilman Margarito Benavides, Jr.
18 All voted in favor.
