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          With a quorum present, the Mayor called the meeting to
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order and the following proceedings were carried out:

A brief presentation was made by Garlos Millarreal regarding the application for "El Cent b Deve opment Project", for an \$8.6 million Urban Development renovation of a grant for the continuing renovation of the dontown area. application provides for an expansion of the Inion National Bank, a new Hachar's Building, and a p aking **a**rage. A \$1.7 million federal grant will provide for public expansion which

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will include the paving of streets, planting of trees and installation of benches, trash receptacles, and street signs.

Mayor Aldo Tatangelo and Councilman Vidal Cantu, Jr.

praised Mr. Carlos Villarreal and his staff for their promptness in putting together the application on such short notice.

Councilman Vidal Cantu, Jr. made a motion to close the Public Hearing and reconvene with the Special City Council Meeting. Second was by Councilman Santos Benavides. All voted in favor.

Next item was a resolution authorizing the submission of a UDAG application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for El Centro Development Project. Motion for its approval was made by Councilman Vidal Cantu, Jr. Second was by Councilman Andres Ramos, Jr. All voted in favor.

Motion for adjournment was made by Councilman Vidal Cantu, Jr. Second was by Councilman Margarito Benavides, Jr. All voted in favor.
