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Due to the unforseen delay of Mayor Tatangelo and Mayor Pro-Tem Carlos Zuniga, Councilman Vidal Cantu, Jr. called the meeting to order. There being a quorum present, the following proceedings were carried out.

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The order of business began with discussion of the FINANCING OF STREET IMPROVEMENTS. This item is a Voluntary Neighborhood Participation Project in which general discussion was held concerning the paving of 3,500 streets. It was estimated that a block would cost \$19,000.00 and included sidewalk, gutter, and driveway. The \$19,000.00 would be financed by the City for a period of five (5) years at 8% interest. Councilman Valdez suggested that a public hearing be held. (No action was taken). Mayor Tatangelo arrived during the course of this discussion and was followed by Councilman Zuniga and at this point assumed the chair.

Mayor Aldo Tatangelo moved that an item (not in the Agenda) be discussed in reference to the Police Sub-Station. Councilman Valdez requested that this item be presented at the next City Council Meeting.

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Next item to be discussed related to the awarding of street improvements, Section 304-ED-101A-Public Works Application Project, to Wright Way Construction Company, Inc., of Harlingen, Texas for the amount of \$90,045.21 out of grant of \$93,750 funded by the Texas Department of Community Affairs (\$18,750) and the U. S. Economic Development Administration (\$75,000) with an additional amount not to exceed \$20,040 to be derived from the street sales proceeds category. Councilman Cantu motioned to accept this project. It was seconded by Councilman Montalvo, and prevailed by the following vote:

Motion to adjourn was made by Councilan Vidal Cantu and seconded by Councilman John Peter Montalvo, All were in favor. Adjournment was at 7:15 P.M.
