With a quorum present, the Mayor called the meeting to order and the following

proceedings were carried out:

Anthony C. McGettrick requested an Executive Session pursuant to Article 6252-17, Section 2(e) to seek approval of proposed settlement of the case of City of Laredo vs. Joe & Sara Gilbert, Cause No.32,145 in the 111th District Court, an eminent domain case.

Alderman Zuniga made a motion to go into Executive Session. Alderman Cantu seconded the motion and all were in favor.

After the Executive Session. Alderman Cantu made a motion to accept a settlement on this case as briefed by the Assistant City Attorney. Alderman Trevino seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Anthony C. McGettrick requested an Executive Session pursuant to Article 6252-17, Section 2(e), to seek approval of proposed settlement of the case of Alicia V. Aguilar, individually and as administratix of the estate of Jose P. Aguilar vs. City of Laredo, et al., Cause No. 32,117 in the 111th District Court, a breach of contract case.

Alderman Zuniga made a motion to go into Executive Session. Alderman Cantu seconded the motion and all were in favor.

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After the Executive Session, Alderman Cantu made a motion to accept a settlement on this case as briefed by the Assistant City Attorney. Alderman Trevino seconded the motion and all were in favor.

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Next was an ordinance awarding the bid for the purchase of a three and a half ton central air unit for the City of Laredo/Legal Department.

AWARDING THE BID FOR THE PURCHASE OF A THREE AND A HALF TON CENTRAL AIR UNIT FOR THE CITY OF LAREDO/LEGAL DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO NECESSARY CONTRACT OR PURCHASE ORDER FOR THE ACQUISITION OF SAID EQUIPMENT OUT OF THE GENERAL FUND, ACCOUNT NO. 01-3102-3000-0000.

The Mayor declared in open meeting that the ordinance had passed.

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The following was an ordinance closing, vacating and abandoning as a public easement that portion of Alamo Street lying between Vidaurri Avenue and Santa Isabel Avenue in the Western Division of the City of Laredo, Webb County, Texas.

Alderman Sanchez made the presentation.

Alderman Ramos questioned if it was legal to close and sell city streets.

Eustorgio Perez, City Attorney, answered that it was legal to close and sell these city streets.

Alderman Sanchez made a motion to adopt the ordinance. Alderman Benavides seconded the motion and it was prevailed by the following vote:

AN ORDINANCE

CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING AS A PUBLIC EASEMENT THAT PORTION OF ALAMO STREET LYING BETWEEN VIDAURRI AVENUE AND SANTA ISABEL AVENUE IN THE WESTERN DIVISION OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, WEBB COUNTY, TEXAS.

The Mayor declared in open meeting that the ordinance had passed.

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Items five (5) through eight (8) were <u>tabled</u> because there was a question as to the legality of contracting Foster Engineering Company since Carlos Mejia, who is now with this company is a former city employee. Mr. Mejia retracted his service proposals to the city.

Alderman Sanchez requested that the Mayor look into the possibility of contracting Foster Engineering Company services with monies other than CDA monies.

The items that were <u>tabled</u> were as follows:

- (7) Ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Laredo to retain Foster Engineering Company to provide certain Engineering Consulting Services for the City in connection with the El Cuatro Pit Project.
- (8) Ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Laredo to retain Foster Engineering Company to provide certain Engineering Consulting Services for the City in connection with the Zacate Creek Project.

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Next was an ordinance granting certain city employees an increase in pay for Fiscal Year 1981-1982.

Mary Solis, Personnel Director, made the presentation.

Alderman Ramos asked if these employees would receive an increase again when the Council accepts an across the board increase or another method of increasing salaries.

Mayor Tatangelo stated that he was figuring on an across the board raise, but that he was also looking at step increases and he felt he was leaning towards the latter.

Alderman Trevino requested that each be taken individually. The motion all the way through was to grant the salary increase requested.

Amador Escudero, Assistant City Engineer, made the presentation before the City Council.

Alderman Ramos made a motion to adopt the ordinance. Alderman Sanchez seconded the motion and all were in favor.

APPROPRIATING \$159,000.00 OUT OF THE CITY OF LAREDO GENERAL FUNDS AND/OR FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING FUNDS, XIII ENTITLEMENT PERIOD TO BEGIN OCTOBER 1, 1981 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PARK-CLARK BRIDGE ACROSS ZACATE CREEK, ITS STREET APPROACHES AND DRAINAGE IMPROVE-MENTS.

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The last item was a public hearing on the proposed area to be annexed. This item was $\underline{\text{tabled}}$ at the request of the Mayor.
