On this the 30th day of December, 1980, the City Council of Laredo, Texas, convened in Special City Council Meeting at the Council Chambers of City Hall at 5:30 P.M., with the following members thereof present, to-wit:

ABSENT: Aldermen Vidal Cantu, Jr., Andres Ramos, Jr., and Enrique Trevino and also City Attorney, Eustorgio Perez.

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With a quorum present, the Mayor called the meeting to order and the following proceedings were carried out:

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The first item was an ordinance awarding bid for the Hillside Road Improvement Project from Zacate Creek to McPherson Road for the Engineering Department and authorizing the Mayor to enter into the necessary contract for the construction of said project and to pay for said project with Neighborhood Participation Paving Program and Federal Revenue Sharing Funds.

The bids submitted were as follows:

Alderman Sanchez made a motion to adopt the ordinance awarding the contract to Victor M. Solis for \$104,699.00 on the Hillside Road Improvements Project. Alderman Zuniga seconded the motion and all were in favor.

### AN ORDINANCE

AWARDING THE BID FOR THE HILLSIDE ROAD IMPROVE-MENTS PROJECT FROM ZACATE CREEK TO MCPHERSON ROAD FOR THE ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT AND AUTHO-RIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO THE NECESSARY CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SAID PROJECT AND TO PAY FOR SAID PROJECT WITH NEIGHBORHOOD PARTICIPATION PAVING PROGRAM AND FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING FUNDS.

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The Mayor declared in open meeting that the ordinance had passed.

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Next was an ordinance increasing the budget for Fiscal Year 1980-81 of the Laredo-Webb County Health Department from \$364,970 to \$369,740 in order to increase the allocation of City of Laredo for salary of X-Ray Technician by \$4,770.

The Mayor stated that there was a correction on the figures from \$364,970 to \$410, 219 and from \$369,740 to \$414,989. Therefore the increase is from \$410,219.00 to \$414, 989.00 by \$4,770.00

Mr. Jose Gonzalez, Health Department Director, stated that the Texas Department of Health had terminated the position and salary insofar as fiscal aid as of January 1, 1981. He requested that the City increase the allocation for salary of X-Ray technician by \$4,770.

Alderman Flores made a motion to adopt the ordinance. Alderman Sanchez seconded the motion and all were in favor.

### AN ORDINANCE

INCREASING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1980-1981 OF THE LAREDO-WEBB COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT FROM \$410,219.00 TO \$414,989.00 IN ORDER TO INCREASE THE SALARY ALLOCATION OF CITY OF LAREDO FOR SALARY OF X-RAY TECHNICIAN BY \$4,770.00.

The Mayor declared in open meeting that the ordinance had passed.

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The following was an ordinance amending the fiscal year 1980-81 budget to add \$2,000.00 to the allocation for the Laredo-Webb County Health Department for salary increase for the Chief of the Animal Control Program.

Mr. Jose Gonzalez, Health Department Director, stated that the reason for this increase was so that the Chief could be available for service calls on weekends.

Alderman Zuniga made a motion to adopt this ordinance. Alderman Flores seconded the motion and all were in favor.

### AN ORDINANCE

INCREASING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1980-1981 OF THE LAREDO-WEBB COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT FROM \$414,989.00 to \$416,989.00 IN ORDER TO INCREASE SALARY OF CHIEF OF THE ANIMAL CONTROL PROGRAM BY \$2,000.00.

The Mayor declared in open meeting that the ordinance had passed.

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Next was an ordinance awarding bid for one (1) 3/4 ton truck for the Parks and Recreation Department.

Alderman Zuniga made a motion to adopt the ordinance awarding the bid to <u>Sames Motor</u>
Co. for the bid price of \$9,136.14. Alderman Guerra seconded the motion and all were in

favor.

AWARDING THE BID FOR ONE 3/4-TON PICK-UP FOR THE PARKS & RECREATION DEPT. AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO THE NECESSARY CONTRACT OR PURCHASE ORDER FOR THE ACQUISITION OF SAID EQUIPMENT AND TO PAY FOR SAID MATERIALS FROM REVENUE SHARING/GENERAL FUND.

The Mayor declared in open meeting that the ordinance had passed.

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The last item was an ordinance authorizing the City Attorney to file condemation proceedings to acquire certain properties for the purpose of furthering the Zacate Creek Beautification Project.

Alderman Flores made a motion to adopt the ordinance. Alderman Sanchez seconded the motion and all were in favor.
