WHEREAS, the above mentioned agencies on May 14, 1970, did agree to participate in a continuing, comprehensive, cooperative transportation planning process for the Laredo Urban Transportation Study Area as provided in the Federal-Aid Highway Act of 1962; and

WHEREAS, The Laredo Urban Transportation Study Area is defined as encompassing all of Laredo and surrounding area as delineated on the map marked "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the parties hereto that the study organization be revised to provide a top committee for guiding the Study to be composed of all elected officials.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO:

That J.C. Martin, Jr., is hereby authorized to execute the attached agreement between the City of Laredo, County of Webb and the State of Texas on behalf of the City of Laredo, and to take such further steps as required under said agreement to carry out the terms and provisions thereof.
