

# DATE: SUBJECT: STAFF REPORT Presenting the preliminary study on restructuring and establishing new water rate 5/3/10 fees necessary to meet future capital improvements for the Waterworks fund of the Utilities Department. Utilities Director PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION: None **BACKGROUND:** Upon acceptance by Council of the Capital Improvements Project proposed by the Utilities Director, CAPEX Consulting Group was authorized on June 2009 to evaluate and provide a proposed rate restructuring to meet the capital demands of the water system. This study has now been substantially completed and Staff and Consultant provide a proposed method of financing these capital improvement needs. It has been determined that the meter size initial fee for the first 2000 gallons provided by the Utility is significantly less than the average water systems within the state. Identifying these significant revenue differences is what focused staff's attention to implementing a base fee for the first 2000 gallons used per meter size connections. And therefore the major cost escalation would be attributable to commercial accounts. A description of the study methodology and the methods of computing the proposed rate increases per meter size will be presented by Consultant and the Utilities Director; and, a short description of the projects to be funded by this increase and the recommendation of approach is to be provided by the Utilities Director.
