

## **C3** Letter Process



The purpose this meeting is to identify potential conflicts on utility plans having excavation along the City of Laredo's ROW. This process is a pre-design function of construction plans. This pre-design process is required to obtain a C3 Letter which is a requirement for obtaining construction permit as per ordinance 2005-O-022.

The Utility Coordination Committee meets each Wednesday at 2 pm via Webex. An application for each project is required a minimum eleven days prior to the meeting to process on a timely manner.

Below are the typical steps to get approval through Utility Coordination Committee.

- 1. The completed application needs to be accompanied with a site plan. (minimum 7 days before the meeting date)
- 2. The site plan should include vicinity map (location map), and all proposed improvements along the City of Laredo's ROW and/or utility easements.
- 3. Once the application and site plan are received, we (Building Development Services) will contact the applicant via email with meeting date and time. The email will include a link to log on to the meeting via Webex.
- 4. At the meeting the applicant presents to the committee the project and scope of work. The committee members provide their existing infrastructure to implement on to the Utility Plan.
- 5. The applicant coordinates with all designers (Civil Engineers, MEP Engineers, Fire Protection Engineers and Architects, if applicable) to revise the Utility Plan
- 6. The applicant resubmits the revised Utility Plan for final approval from each member of the committee.
- 7. The Utilities Coordination Manager signs and sends a letter to the applicant allowing the project to apply for a construction permit.
