Dear Mayor and Council Members:

The Laredo Center for Urban Agriculture and Sustainability would like to thank you for the opportunity to submit our biannual report that shows our progress in achieving our goals for the Laredo Community.

Organized as a City of Laredo Local Government Corporation, our board is uniquely comprised of a combination of City officials & private citizens to provide a dynamic collaboration of insights and efforts. As always, we hope that our work projects our best efforts to serve as City appointed officials in advising you, our elected officials, to move towards new standards of development of citywide programs for urban agriculture, sustainability, and food system initiatives.

The mission of LCUAS is dedicated to the creation of an urban food system by increasing access to local fresh food for low income citizens and the community at large; offering educational programs that surround urban agriculture, community gardens, home gardens, farmers markets, and farm to school programs; providing entrepreneurial opportunities for urban farmers; cultivating xeriscaping and sustainability practices; facilitating the Laredo Food Policy Council; and developing policy and incentives for the local food industry.

The second half of 2024 has provided an opportunity for the Laredo Center for Urban Agriculture and Sustainability to focus on the future with its Council approved 3 year contract and funding for capacity building and lease of the Canseco House property. LCUAS will more robustly continue creating and promoting an urban food system for the City of Laredo; offering educational programs for farmers, growers, gardeners, and consumers to learn; and participate in the development of local and regional food systems; developing community-supported agriculture; cultivating water, soil, and air sustainability opportunities; providing the on going implementation of a city-wide food security plan; and aiding in the creation of policies and incentives for the local food industry.

The LCUAS community garden has had 43 applicants for volunteering at the community garden, and has partnered with 18 organizations for the fulfillment of its commitments. It has continued to be a source of produce for the farmer's market. Additionally, the LCUAS has progressed in its facilitation of the Laredo Food Policy Council and together fostering a healthier food system. LCUAS and the Laredo Food Policy Council have held 6 total meetings and is currently teaming on the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual "Food Town" Laredo, Tx Symposium tittled, <u>Laredo's Culinary Culture</u>.

LCUAS Board Members are optimistic about a future of great growth in the general education of community agriculture and sustainable food systems in our community.
