ORDINANCE NO. 2012-O-152

AMENDING CHAPTER 11 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCE (ELECTRICITY) OF THE CITY OF LAREDO BY AMENDING ARTICLE III SECTION 11-44 (PERMIT FEES) BY INCREASING THE BASIC PERMIT FEE FROM \$25.00 TO \$50.00; AND METER RECONNECTION INSPECTION FEE FROM \$20.00 TO \$25.00; INCREASING PER ITEM FEES; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND/OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has deemed it appropriate to adopt the National Electrical Code, 2008 Edition; to further safeguard the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Laredo; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that electrical inspection fees should be increased to defray the costs of inspections; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Laredo that:

That Section 11-44 (Permit Fees) of the Code of Ordinances hereby be amended to read as follows:

<u>Section 2.</u> That if any provision or any section of this ordinance shall be held to be void or unconstitutional, such holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining provisions or sections of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 3</u>: That this ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 4</u>. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and publication as provided by the Charter of the City of Laredo, Texas.
