1. 2013-R-093 Declaration of a Public Disaster Emergency for the neighborhoods of the San Jose Subdivision Phases 9, 10 and 11, and the residential area at Candela Road adjacent to Highway 59, due to an uncommonly heavy rain event that occurred on October 13, 2013, which resulted in severe flooding and the displacement of residents; providing the expenditure of public resources to provide temporary shelter for the displaced families; to assist in the clean-up and repair of damaged homes for purposes of restoring the health and safety of the general public; to assist clean-up of debris in an adjacent private creek for purposes of protecting the general public from future flooding; and to ratify emergency expenditures made to date.

2. Discussion with possible action on amending Section 24-1.1.1.3 of the Laredo Code of Ordinances, entitled Planning and Zoning Commission, duties and powers, to include as part of the planning process the Laredo City Council's approval in addition to that of the Planning and Zoning Commission of platting, re-platting, or subdividing land within the corporate limits of the City of Laredo and within area of extraterritorial jurisdiction.

Orlando Navarro stated that he was representing the Laredo Builders Association. He invited City Manager Carlos Villarreal and Council to discuss development in general.

Cm. Vela stated that they had talked about raising elevations and about the drainage ordinance. He went on to say that the deadline on when developments were accepted

was important.

Motion to include the developers during discussions of raising elevations, amendment of the drainage ordinance and the time period in which subdivisions are accepted by the city, and to close the loopholes during the rezoning process in which an R-1 becomes an R-1MH.
