PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION

BACKGROUND

The proposed project will include the construction of two new taxiway connectors between Runway 18R-36L and Taxiway G and the decommissioning of Taxiway D between Runway 18R-36L and Taxiway G. The taxiway connectors include new concrete pavement, asphalt shoulder section, drainage, taxiway lighting, and taxiway signage. Taxiway D has a direct access from the cargo and general aviation west apron to Runway 18R-36L. A direct access from an apron to a runway does not conform to FAA standards as described in AC 150/5300-13A Change 1. A portion of the existing Taxiway D will be demolished to maintain a 15 feet wide service road from Runway 18R-36L to Taxiway G. In addition, the new service road will be milled and overlaid.

ORDINANCE 2021-O-XXX

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RATIFY THE ACCEPTANCE OF FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION GRANT NO. 3-48-0136-095-2021 AND AMEND THE CITY OF LAREDO FY 2021 AIRPORT CONSTRUCTION BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE THE GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,188,272. THE PURPOSE OF THE GRANT IS TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TAXIWAYS G1 AND G2. 100% FEDERAL FUNDS; NO LOCAL MATCH IS REQUIRED. FEDERAL GRANT FUNDING IS AVAILABLE UNDER THE AIRPORT CONSTRUCTION FUND.

WHEREAS, the Airport Director recommends the Mayor and City Council to authorize the City Manager to ratify the acceptance of Federal Aviation Administration Grant No. 3-48-0136-095-2021 and amend the City of Laredo FY 2021 Airport Construction Budget to appropriate the grant funds in the amount of \$9,188,272. The purpose of the grant is to provide funding for the construction of Taxiways G1 and G2. 100% Federal funds; no local match is required. Federal grant funding is available under the Airport Construction Fund;

WHEREAS, the Airport Advisory Board finds the said grant is in the best interest of the Airport and recommends that the Mayor and City Council accept and appropriate the budget; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Laredo having heard the recommendations of the Airport Director and of the Airport Advisory Board agrees with same.

The purpose of the grant is to provide funding for the construction of Taxiways G1 and G2. 100% Federal funds; no local match is required. Federal grant funding is available under the Airport Construction Fund.

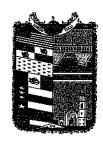
